



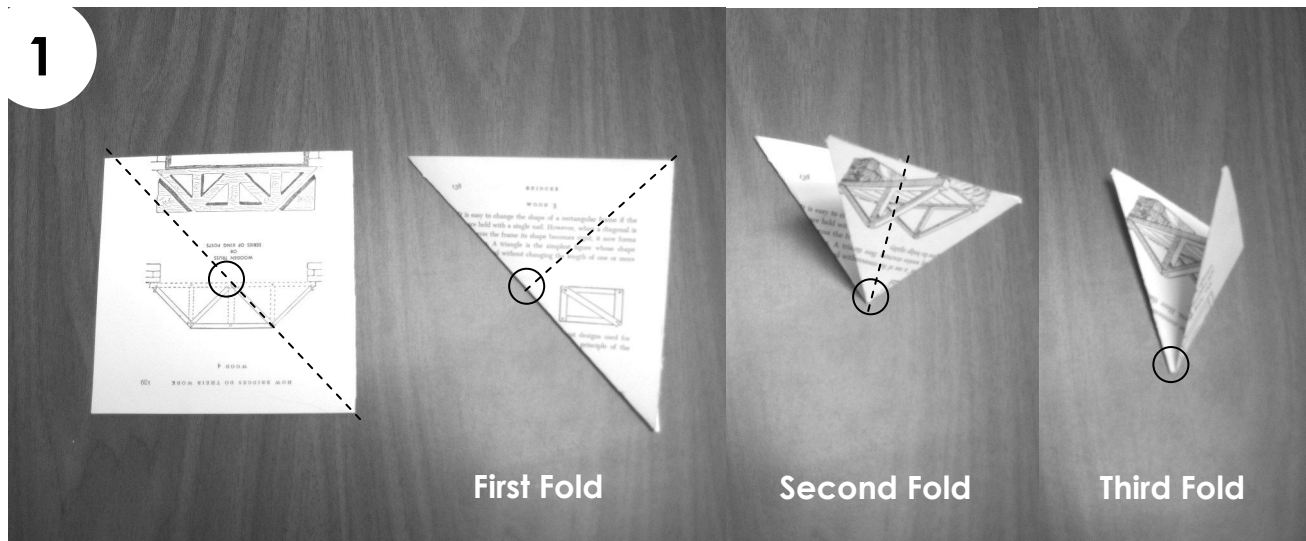
HOW TO MAKE A PAPER ROSE

MATERIALS

Makes one (1) Rose:

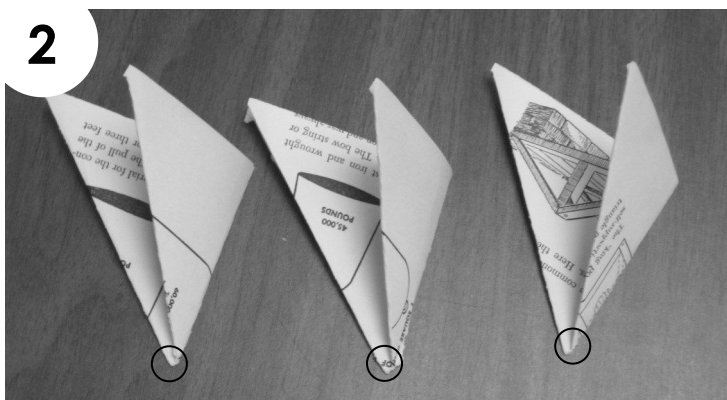
1. Three (3), square pieces of paper
2. One (1) pipe cleaner
3. A glue stick
4. A pair of scissors
5. Tape

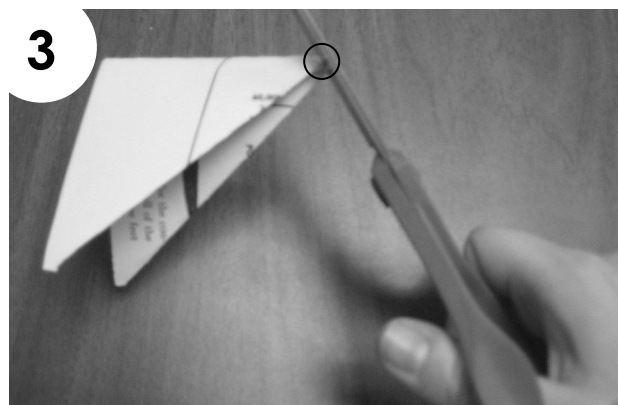
Fold one of the pieces of paper into a triangle, three times (see the dotted lines above)
Keep track of the center of the paper (see the black circles)

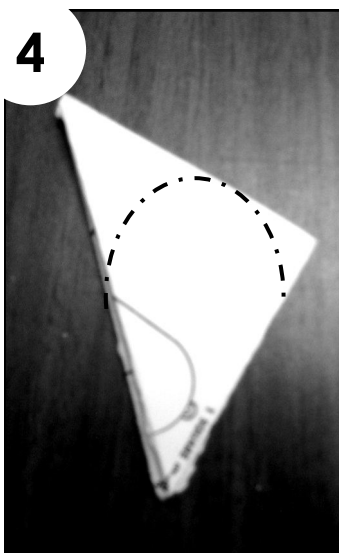
Repeat these folds on two other paper squares
so you have three folded triangles total

Cut off the center tip of the triangle
A TINY snip will do

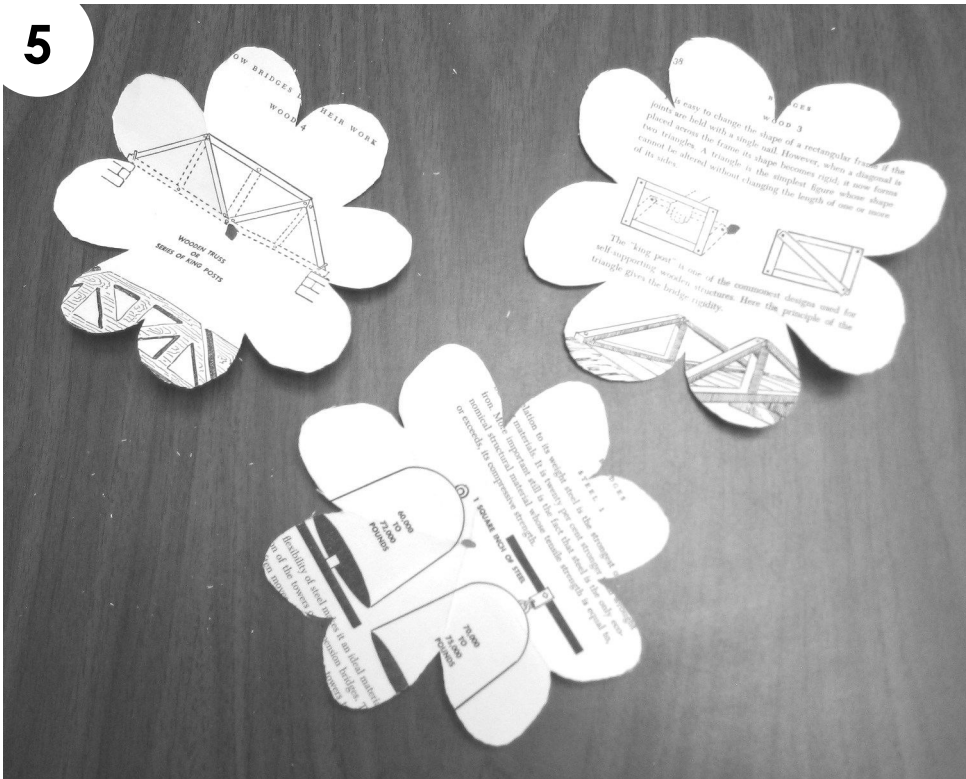


Cut along the dotted line
(see picture on the left)
to create the flower petals.
Optional: get creative with your
petal shapes here

Repeat for all three folded
triangles and then open them
up (see next page)

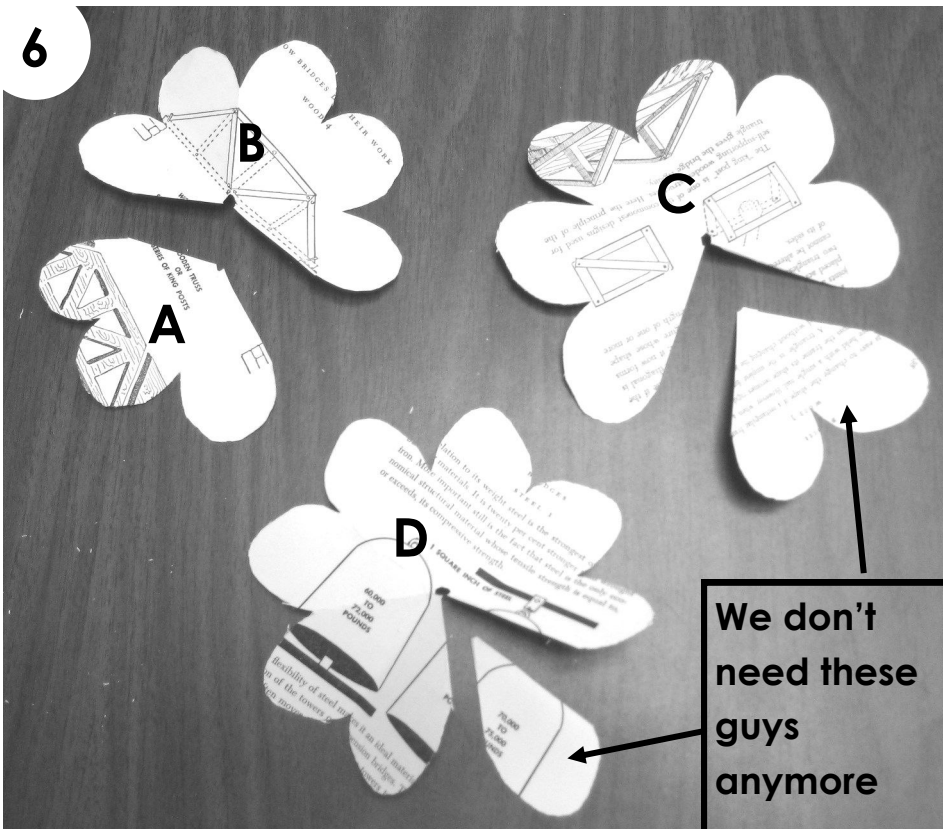


Unfold! At this point you should have:

- * three, flower-shaped pieces of paper
- * a small hole in the center of each paper

Don't worry if your petals are not perfect. As long as you see eight individual petals on each paper, you're doing great!

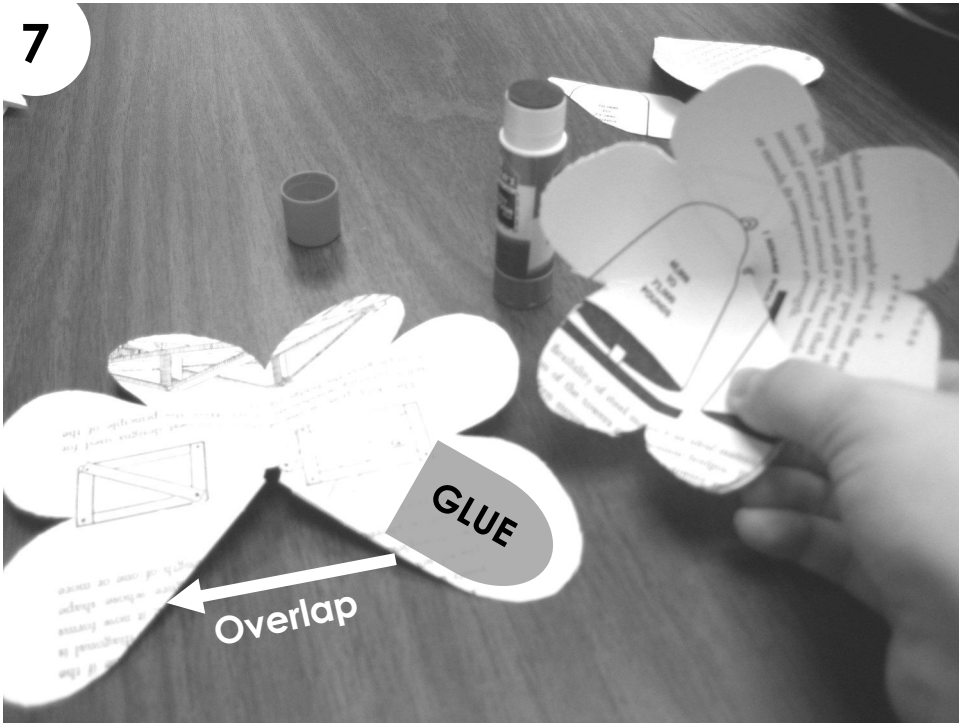


Snip out sections of each petal as shown to the left.

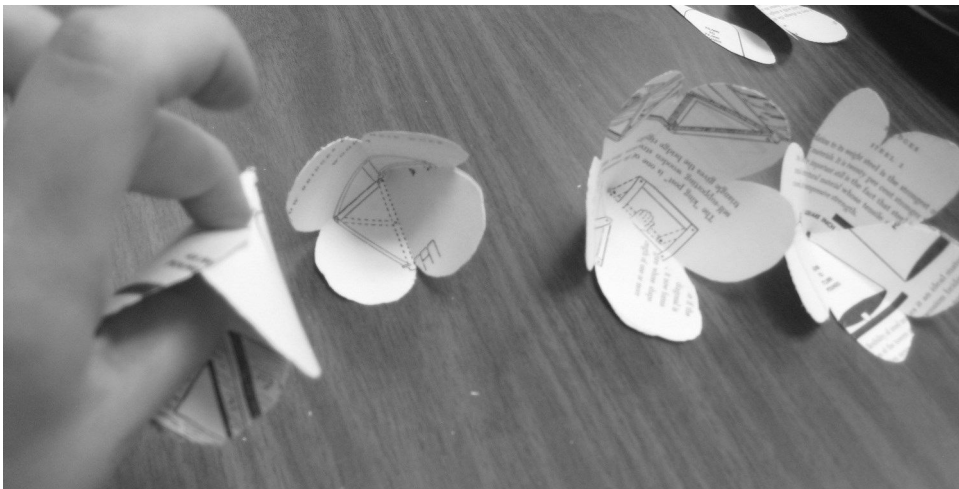
- * Snip 3 petals out from the first flower (SAVE THIS PIECE)
- * Snip 2 petals out from the next flower
- * Snip 1 petal out from the last flower

You need the four pieces that are labeled with letters.

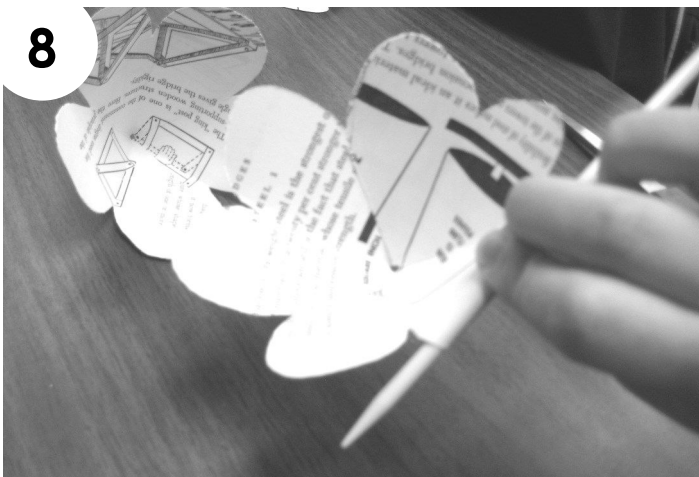


For the three largest flower pieces (B - D):
Put glue on one of the end petals and stick it to the other end petal.
(see left)



For the smallest flower piece (A), overlap the two end pieces a little bit with glue; tape together if needed.
You should now have four flower petal cones.

Optional:

For a realistic flower look, wrap the end of each petal around a pencil or tooth pick until it is curled.

Stack up your petal cones in size order, with the smallest on the inside and the largest on the outside.

Then bend the end of a pipe cleaner, and stick it through the hole in the middle of all of the stacked petals.
